Alireza has scored several films made by my film production students, including senior project films. I have found both his work and his work ethic to be of a very high standard. Like all good film composers, Alireza not only writes well-crafted music but also understands how it fits into the dramatic context of the film. His music is then able to bring out the subtext of character and story that, to my mind, is the principle job of a film score. He also understands the relationship between music and sound effects so his music felt natural and congruent with the sound design of the films he's worked on. He is also an excellent collaborator. The filmmakers he's worked with have all felt he was an ally and were delighted with the high quality of work, which enhanced theirs. With one senior project film, when the sound editors fell behind in their schedule he pitched in and picked up the slack so the film could be completed on schedule.

In conclusion, I find him to be impressive as a composer, a collaborator, as someone who understands drama and character, and as a guy who gets it done. I unhesitatingly recommend him to you for any project involving film, music and sound.
